Duke University sets the minimum score needed to qualify for the opportunity to participate.



What?

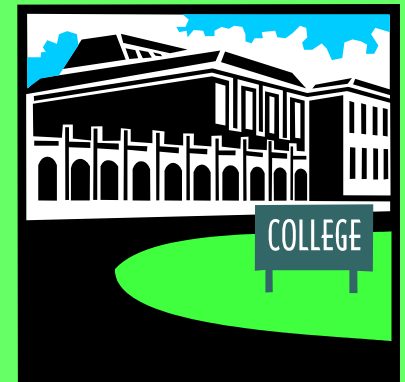
The Duke Talent Identification Program provides high achieving students the opportunity to participate in an above-level testing experience. Participating students will choose to take either the **SAT** or **ACT**.



Why?

- Experience of a high-stakes test

- Preview of college entrance exam
- Opportunity to be recognized for exceptional scores
